Plain black shorts

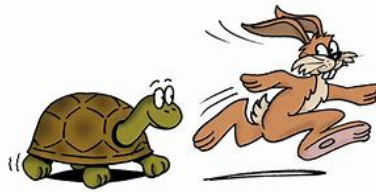
Plimsolls
