Following the cancelled library visits last term, we have re-scheduled these for next week:

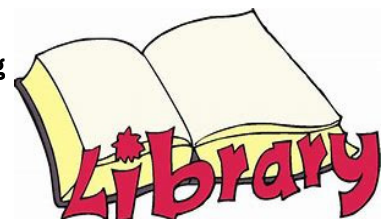
