Our new Reception children have all joined Class Dojo so we are getting to know them through their lovely posts to help them with their transition.

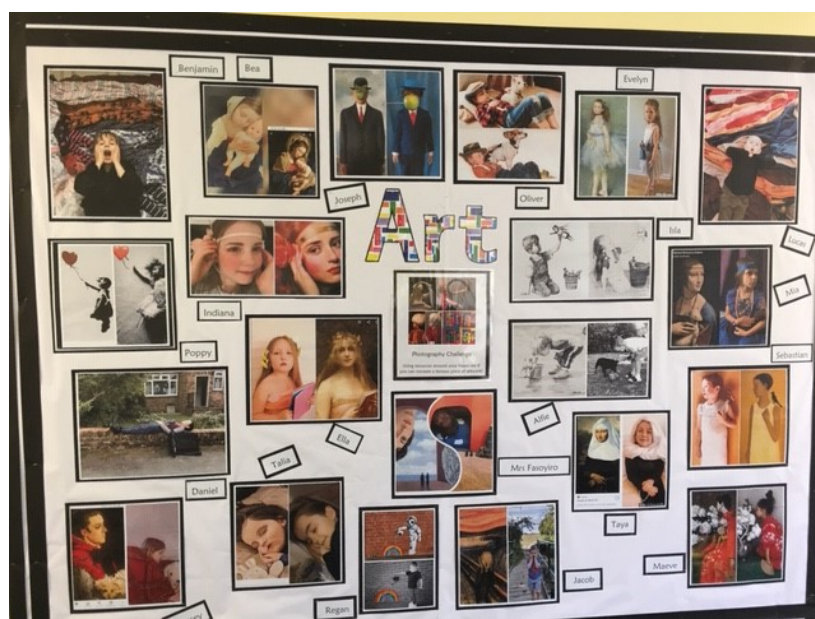
