Message from Admissions

In an effort to reduce the number of late applications received, we would like to remind parents of those in Nursery (in their second year) and Year 2, that the national closing date for Reception and Junior applications for September 2021 entry is **15 January 2021**.

We strongly encourage online applications via https://www.eadmissions.org.uk/eAdmissions/app. If parents are unable to apply online, they will need to request a paper application form via the Surrey Schools & Childcare Service (0300 200 1004, Mon-Fri 9am-5pm). The completed paper application form must be received by Admissions (to our Quadrant Court address) by 15 January, so parents must allow time for the post to reach us. If parents need to apply on paper, we recommend that they send applications by recorded post.

Full information is available on Surrey's website at www.surreycc.gov.uk/primaryadmissions. The Surrey Schools & Childcare Service can also provide impartial help in completing an application. Applications received after the closing date without good reason will be treated as late and will not be considered until all on time applications have been processed. This may jeopardise the chance of a parent being offered one of their preferred schools for their child.
