Within school, teachers are busily planning and preparing exciting opportunities for Book Week, so look forward to hearing about lots of amazing learning!

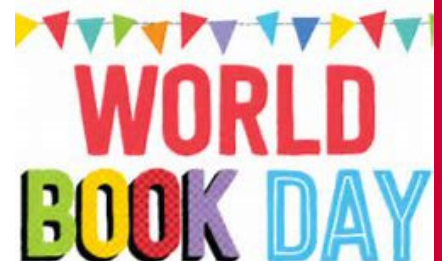
There will be a book fair which will be open from Monday 26th so please do come along and spend some money!
