PARENT FEEDBACK—HOME LEARNING

63% of parents were "Highly Satisfied" with the Home Learning

The remaining 37% were "Satisfied"

100% of parents felt they could get in touch successfully with a teacher over any concerns

Amount of work set—97% felt it was the right amount, the remaining 3% said there was too much

Positive feedback:

I am very happy with the way things have been done, with all the support from the teachers and school it couldn't be more perfect due to the circumstances.

There is clearly a lot of effort being spent by the teachers in setting work and commenting on the posts which is greatly appreciated.

We have really enjoyed the morning registration as it is really good to see classmates and teacher etc. We also enjoy the head teachers assemblies.

The work has been easy to access and the teachers are very hands on with answering any questions we may have about the work.

What could be done better?

A few live lessons so children could have more contact with their teacher and peers.

It would be really helpful if work could be posted on Dojo earlier so I can plan in advance.

It would also be helpful if documents / worksheets could be edited online rather than printed but I suspect that Dojo might not allow for this.

Maybe have the weeks work sent out on a Sunday. So can plan for the week ahead around work commitments.

All feedback has been passed on to staff and will be used to improve Home Learning if we need to return to this at any stage
