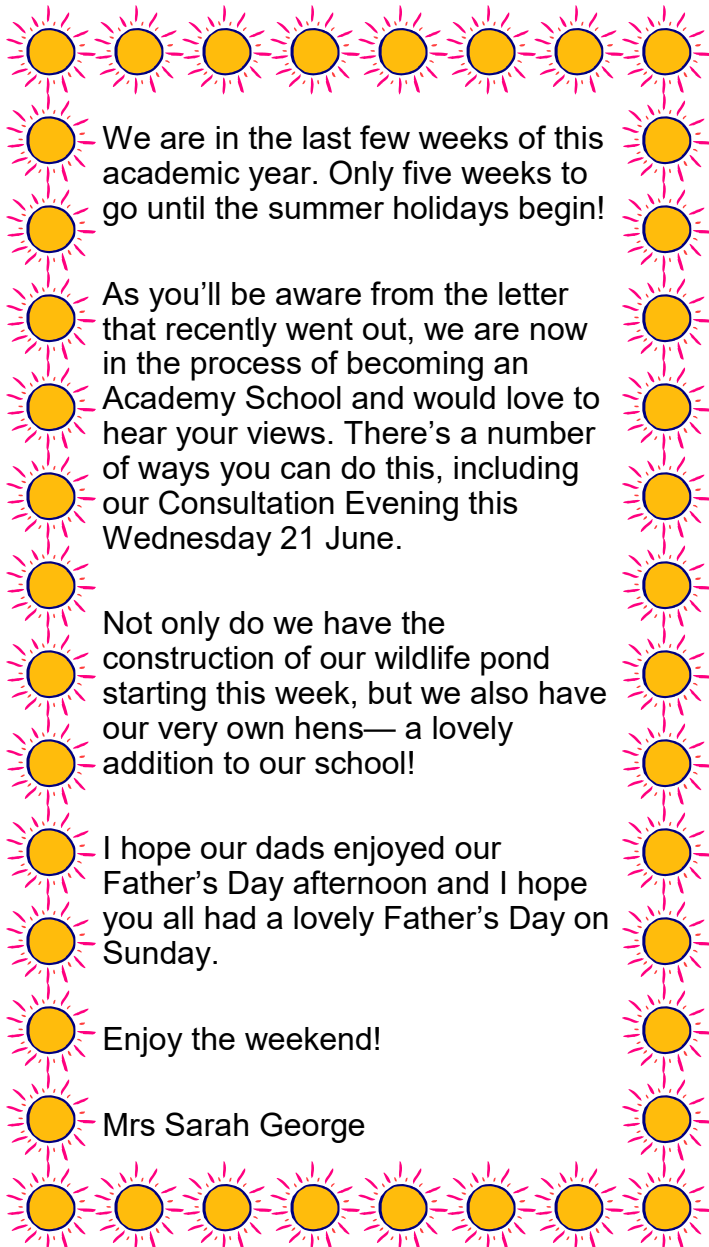


Hurst Green Happenings

Introducing... Our School Chickens

We are very excited to share the news with you all that we are the proud new owners of some school chickens!

You may remember that we recently took part in the Hatching Eggs project? Well, three of the hens that were incubated here have stayed. One has already been named Hobbles (she was born with a bad leg and nursed back to health by Miss Douglas and Mrs Sone) and we will soon be naming the other two with the help of our children.

The 'girls', as we fondly refer to them, are in a temporary coop outside Reception's classroom, where they receive a lot of attention! When they are old enough, they'll set up their permanent home in a large walk-in run (thanks to the HGSA for their help with this) where they'll have the space and freedom to flap, scratch, explore and climb, and be happy hens.

Children (if they wish) will be fully involved in looking after the chickens, including helping with enrichment, feeding and collecting fresh eggs.



TRANSITION WORKSHOP

We understand that parents will want to support their children so that they are confident and ready to start their next journey.

This year the school are delighted to hold a workshop for parents to prepare them for their children's imminent transition to junior school. This is the first time this event has been held and if enough parents come, we hope to hold more wellbeing workshops like this next year.

The workshop will take place at Hurst Green Infant School and last around an hour. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be served.

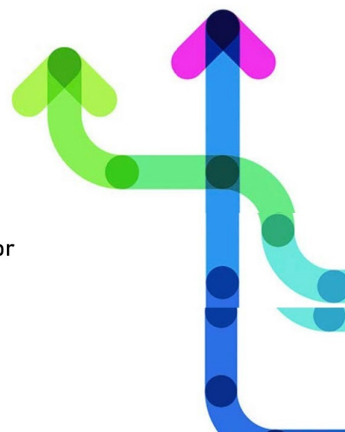

Term Time Holidays and Fines

As parents, you have a legal responsibility to ensure your child's attendance at school.

The Education (Pupil Registration)(England)(Amendment) Regulations 2013, state that Head Teachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. The Head Teacher is also required to determine the number of school days a child can be away from school if leave is granted.

Unauthorised absence of 5 days or more will result in the issue of a Penalty Notice. Penalty Notices are issued by the Local Authority in accordance with Surrey County Council's Code of Conduct. The Penalty Notice is £60, per child per parent/carer, if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after 21 days but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in the Local Authority considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.

The Head Teacher will consider the reasons for the request carefully and will notify you of the decision. If you are taking your child out of school for a holiday or any other reason other than medical, please ask the school office for a Leave of Absence Form.
