


## Hurst Green Happenings 26 May 2023


The workshop will take place at Hurst Green Infant School and last around an hour. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be served.






# COMMUNITY CONSULTATION DROP IN CLINIC: 3 JUNE, 9:00-14:00, ST AGATHA'S HALL

Heraldic coats of arms became popular in Europe from the 12<sup>th</sup> Century, and were an easy way of identifying individual knights, particularly when they

wore full armour in combat. Heraldic symbols typically were mythical beasts such as unicorns, weapons such as swords or axes, or were simple shapes in bright colours. Tandridge Council's arms even has a grasshopper - what favourite animal or object will be in your coat of arms??

We'll also have our popular Museum trails to do, please come and join us if you can.
