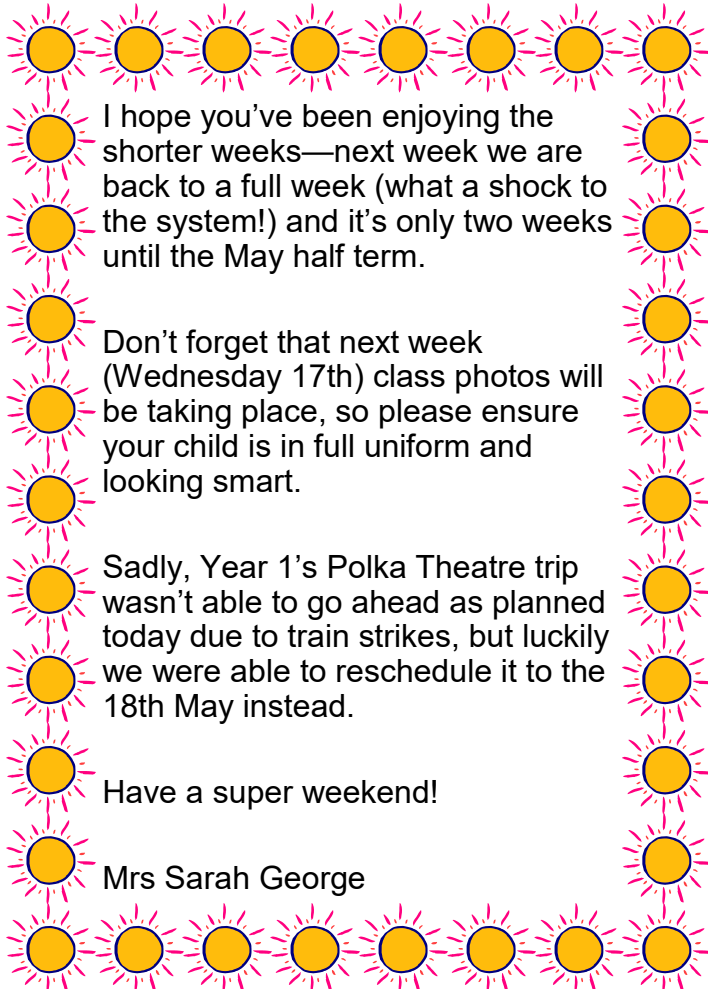


Hurst Green Happenings

Community Courtyard Project... A message from Dr Anna Mustill:

"Some months ago, as part of initiatives to keep our community healthy and vibrant, it was proposed to install a "courtyard" in front of the shops in Pollards Oak Road, where local people could sit and chat within a pleasant environment of plants and shrubs. There would be seats and picnic benches and the area would have a surrounding low level wooden fence. There may also be features which local schools could help make. We're hoping that the vegetation could be tended by local volunteers.

A team of HG residents, a local GP, a health manager, a local care worker and councillors has been in place a few months to speak with the local residents and shops, and come up with a draft plan of what the area might look like. What we'd like to do now is get the views and ideas of more HG people and to ask them to comment on our draft plan, before we confirm the layout and seek tenders from local contractors to construct it. To do this, we've planned a drop-in for local residents and we would love to see as many of you there as possible !

Saturday 3rd June in St Agatha's Hall, 9am to 2pm.

We are pleased to confirm that based on our estimated costs, we have secured the funding for the project and have obtained the required licence from the landlord Tandridge DC. Finally, the Parish Council is expecting to install CCTV close-by."

Dr Anna Mustill will also be coming along to school pick-up on Friday 19 May to talk to parents and carers about the exciting plans.

Did you know?

Rhubarb is rich in antioxidants which have anti-bacterial, anti-inflammatory, and anti-cancer properties, protecting you from many health-related issues.

METHOD

- Tip 500g small chunks of rhubarb into a saucepan with 100g golden caster sugar.
- Cover and simmer on a very low heat for 15 mins, adding more sugar if you want. When soft (but still holding its shape) and sweet enough, pour the rhubarb into a medium baking dish.
- Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6.
- For the topping - rub 140g self-raising flour and 85g chilled butter together with your fingers until you have a soft, crumbly mix.
- Now add 50g light brown muscovado sugar and 50g chopped walnuts (optional) and mix together with your hands.
- Scatter the topping over the rhubarb and bake for 30 mins or until golden brown on top and serve with cream, vanilla custard or ice cream!

- 500G RHUBARB, CHOPPED INTO CHUNKS
- 100G GOLDEN CASTER SUGAR
- 140G SELF-RAISING FLOUR
- 85G BUTTER, CHILLED
- 50G LIGHT BROWN MUSCOVADO SUGAR
- 50G CHOPPED WALNUTS (OPTIONAL)

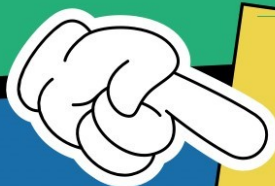
