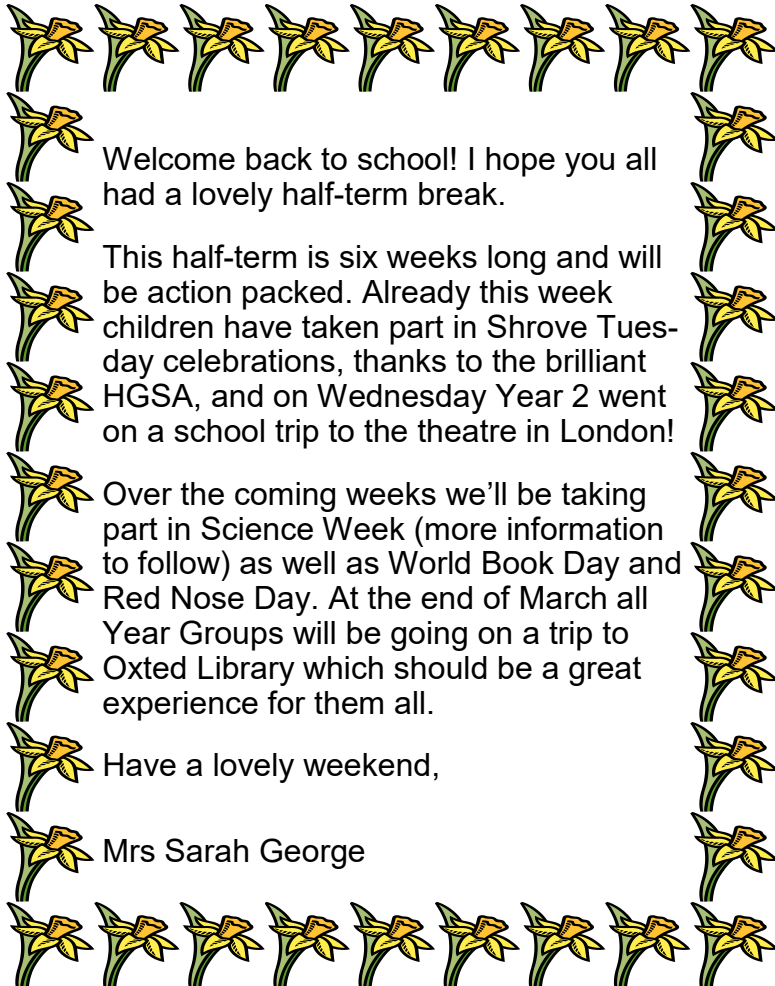


Hurst Green Happenings
