#### **Food Glorious Food**



### **New Reception Outside Space**

Our new Reception children have been enjoying getting to know their new classroom, especially the lovely outside area. Big thanks to Miss Douglas and Mr Parrett who worked hard over the summer holiday to give the outside play and learning area a facelift. There's lots of sensory and interactive equipment to help the children's learning, enabling them to have fun and grow in confidence, including a mud kitchen, a bark floor, ladders and wooden stepping stones. We've also removed the fence, which used to separate the Reception and Year 1 outside areas, so the two year groups can get to know each other when they are playing outdoors.



#### School Attendance

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their child out of school for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), you will be liable to receive a penalty notice. The amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child, so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices.


