


Hurst Green Happenings 20 October 2023

Trees for Hurst Green



In November we'll be receiving 420 native saplings (small trees) from Woodland Trust as part of their Free Trees for Schools initiative. These saplings will be planted along the back fence of our school field to form a wildlife-friendly hedgerow full of flowers and berries. Once we know a delivery date, we'll be organising a volunteering day to help plant the trees and would love your help.

The Tree Planting team at Surrey County Council are also sending us some free apple trees around the same time so that we can create our very first school orchard. This will be such a fantastic learning resource for the children where they will be able to learn so much, including how fruit grows, how apples are pollinated and also the simple and joyful experience of picking apples from a tree!
