


Hurst Green Happenings 24 November 2023

Saturday. We now have five fruit trees (apples and pears) planted in our meadow area, which will be a fantastic

learning resource for our children.

Our incredible and hardworking volunteers also planted over 400 native tree whips (hazel, hawthorn, silver birch, rowan

and oak) which will hopefully grow into a beautiful wildlife-friendly hedgerow
